The mission: practical engagement into the art of contemporary music improvisation for stimulating creativity and improving professional music skills.

Number of participants in each group – 15-25 people

Content (72 hours)

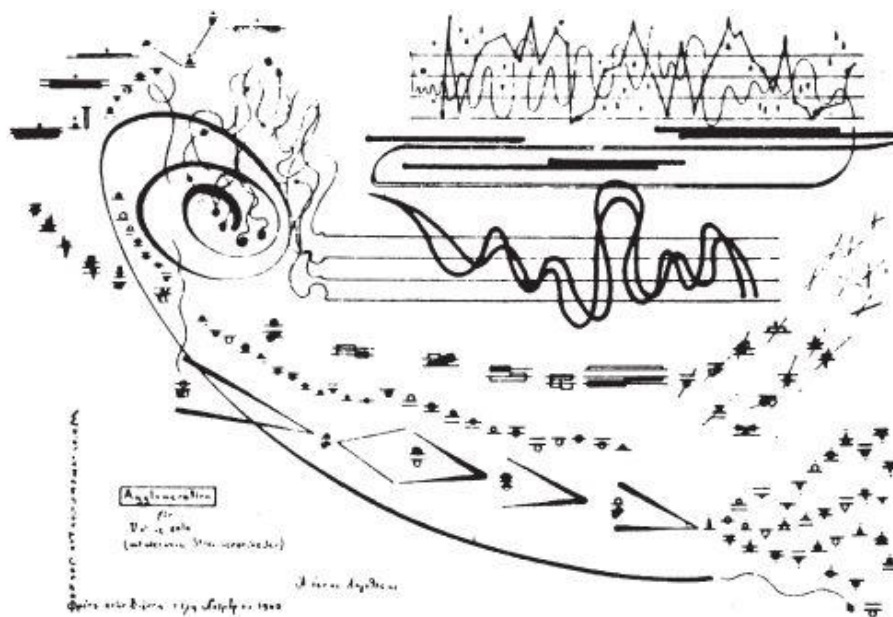
Individual improvisation — practical lessons on improvisation combining advancement of performer's skills throughout studying notated material with exploring various improvisational techniques.

Group improvisation (ensemble) — exploring different ways of interaction within group of improvisers using various improvisational techniques.

History of music improvisation — series of lectures embracing history of improvisation in music from traditional societies to the end of 20th century.

New music technologies – a guide throughout electronic and electroacoustic music (principles of synthesis of sound, concrete music, floating sounds effects, etc.) and music computer software.

New composition techniques – twelve-tone technique, total serialism, chance operations, minimalism, open scores, spectralism and other techniques of new music.



Every participant of the educational program will receive a diploma of International Academy of Arts.
